



## Trivia Night FAQ's

### **I know very little about Hollywood trivia. Is this for me?**

YES it is!! Individuals are never asked to give answers alone. Answers are discussed at your table. You might be surprised what knowledge you have hidden inside. Questions can be about music, television, movies, actors or actresses.

### **How many people can we have on our team?**

A maximum of eight (8) people are allowed at a table. Most people fill their table. But individuals can be placed with other individuals to make a table of eight.

### **What will happen at Trivia Night?**

You're in for an evening of FUN! Plan to arrive at 6:30. We will begin the evening with a buffet dinner, drinks and social time. There is a short presentation from The Boys and Girls Club. You may hear from the Youth of the Year or one of The Clubs many volunteers. Then competition will begin. Half way through the questions there will be a brief intermission. Trivia Night is designed for adults ages 21 and over. The cost of the buffet dinner and all drinks are included in your registration fee.

### **Is there anything else besides trivia?**

Yes. This event is a major fundraising event for the Boys and Girls Club so we do have a silent auction. We also have the opportunity to sponsor a child for The Club's summer program.

### **Are there other competitions?**

Absolutely!! In addition to naming a trivia champion, there will also be prizes to the teams judged the best in the following categories:

- Table Decoration
- Costume
- Rassie Award (lowest trivia score!)

### **What should I wear?**

Teams are encouraged to dress based on the theme of their team name. For those that are shy about a taking on a Hollywood look, jeans are appropriate. It is very much a casual atmosphere.

### **Can you tell me exactly how the Trivia Competition works?**

Teams are at tables with answer sheets. The emcee will read the question, which will also be displayed on a big screen. Teams will have a short time to write down their answer. We will have runners in the room to pick up your answer and deliver it to the scoring table. After all the score sheets have been collected, the emcee will then provide everyone with the correct answer and quickly move on to the next question. After we have completed all the questions, the winning team will be revealed.

### **What if our team needs help with a question?**

Sorry. No cell phones allowed!

### **How will team answers be scored?**

Every correct answer yields one point. The team with the highest score wins. Tie-breaking questions will be offered in the event of a tie.

### **What do we receive if our team wins?**

The winning team will be awarded the Trivia Night traveling trophy, which you'll want to display proudly for the year you hold the crown.
